United Way of the Dutchess-Orange Region is a 501c3 that functions as a large community platform that allows for individuals, organizations and corporations in the local area to express their philanthropic spirit by providing resources, funding or volunteer opportunities.



Donations made to United Way are allocated and distributed through the community by either helping individuals in need with the funds required to succeed and get on their feet, or to local nonprofit to support their mission. Donated new merchandise from local retailers helped more than 7,000 individuals in 2019 within the region through United Way's Day of Sharing and Louis Greenspan Children's Corner.
